1 Cor 10:31

Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

Are you practicing this verse, especially this part: whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. Yeah, at church and around our Christian friends maybe, because we all make sure we are putting on our Sunday best then.

But what about when you are home and no one else is around? No wife or husband or kids or friends or brothers or sisters, no one, just you and you. When you are all alone, what DVD's are you slipping into the DVD player or what Netflix movies are you downloading?

What websites are you going to?

What books or magazines are you checking out?

What kind of music are you listening to?

Who are you texting and what are you texting them?

Jesus had a name for such people who live a double life:

₱ Matt 23:27 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which indeed appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.

"Whitewashed tombs" which is looking so good and cool and pure and holy on the outside. But inside, or when no one else is around, looking like the old man that was crucified and should be dead.

- Romans 6:6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.
- ₱ Eph 4:22-24 that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.
- † Col 3:9-10 Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him.

So which are you, or which do you want to be, a *Whitewashed Tomb*, or a *New Man* (or woman) in Christ Jesus? It's your choice, and the way to know is to look at yourself and the things that you do when you are alone.
