

## 2 Corinthians 6:15-18

*And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As*

*God has said:*

*"I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."*

*Therefore*

*"Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you."*

*"I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty."*

So many people are allowing sin to run rampant in this Country, and the excuse that they use is that we are being unloving towards these people if we speak against their sin.

Back up a step and understand that I am referring to June being called "**Pride**" month, and so many people, including a lot of Christians, have jumped onboard defending it, while this country spirals deeper into the pit of hell.

‡ **Proverbs 11:2** *When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble is wisdom.*

‡ **Proverbs 16:18** *Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall.*

Unfortunately there has been division and arguments within the church because the month of June has been declared "**Sin**" month, yep, the whole "**Pride**" movement is all about being accepting of sin, as well as celebrating sin. And if we are not accepting of sin, then we are called unloving by our brothers and sisters in the church, as well as those outside the church.

So, should I be loving and accept a murderer and not address his or her sin of murder, being afraid I am unloving if I say something about their sin of murder, and allow them to be free to come and murder any of my family or friends or even strangers?

No, I will not accept murder. Why? One, because it's sin, and two, because I need to protect my family from sin that could harm them.

Would you allow a child molester to sleep in the same room, or even in your home as your little child or grandkids are in? Would you be labeled as unloving if you don't allow them to express their sexual preference of molesting little children? Yet we are allowing them to live their sinful lifestyle here in the USA, and we are called unloving if we don't.

People try to quote the verse about removing the log in your own eye and the speck in others eyes, or judge not least you be judged, totally taking these verses out of context. Once again I will protect my family and the country that I live in against sin. I will not be accepting of it, and just because I choose not to be accepting of sin does not mean I have sentenced that person to hell. That's not my job, that's for God to decide.

† **1 Corinthians 5:12-13** *For what have I to do with judging those also who are outside? Do you not judge those who are inside? But those who are outside God judges. Therefore "put away from yourselves the evil person."*

When God brought the children of Israel out of Egypt and took them to the Promised Land, He said to destroy the sinful things and the people in the land so that they would not be polluted with their sins. Israel did for a while, but then they started to give in to the sins of the land, which destroyed them. **But God** (Love those two words) in His love, grace and mercy, forgave them and as they repent, they are returning to the Promised Land (Israel) and are being saved. And I believe that God will heal our land and the church as we repent of these things, as well as remove the sin from our land that we have allowed to run rampant.

But God never told Israel to be accepting of the sins of the people in the land where He was leading them to, and just love on them. But rather to fight against the sin they were committing. God said to destroy the idols and abominable things in the land. Don't even touch them or speak their names (of their false gods), get rid of them.

† **Exodus 23:13 (NLT2)** *Pay close attention to all my instructions. You must not call on the name of any other gods. Do not even speak their names.*

So am I without sin? Nope, not at all. I am far from perfect, but it is not an excuse to allow sin to take over my home, the church, or my country that I love. God says to be holy for I am holy, so I strive for that.

† **Leviticus 20:26** *And you shall be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy, and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine.*

God can not be in the presence of sin, therefore He had to make a way for sinful man to come to Him, and that was through His Son Jesus Christ.

† **John 14:6** *Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.*

We read of the woman caught in adultery, and nowhere does Jesus say that He accepted her adultery, in fact Jesus said, "**Go and sin no more**" **John 8:11**. Yet today, people would say Jesus was unloving because He was not accepting of her sin, and that Jesus' words were unloving and judgmental. But that's not true, by Jesus saying, "**Go and sin no more**" He was being loving, because He knows how much sin destroys a life, and the sin of adultery destroys not only the two people involved in it, but their entire families and friends. Just like the whole Pride movement is destroying these people, their family and friends, and our nation. To be unloving is to allow it to continue and to destroy others lives who are committing these sins as well as destroy the lives of those who love them.

**Jesus died on the cross to defeat sin, not defend it.**

The church needs to stop defending sin, and start defeating sin in our homes, in the church and in our Nation and no longer accepting it. If not, then the USA will have a place in hell, right next to Sodom and Gomorrah.

- † **Matthew 11:23-24** *And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades; for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. But I say to you that it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment than for you.*
- † **Ezekiel 18:30 (NLT2)** *Therefore, I will judge each of you, O people of Israel, according to your actions, says the Sovereign LORD. Repent, and turn from your sins. Don't let them destroy you!*
- † **Luke 13:1-3** *There were present at that season some who told Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. And Jesus answered and said to them, "Do you suppose that these Galileans were worse sinners than all other Galileans, because they suffered such things? I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish."*
- † **Revelation 2:5** *Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place--unless you repent.*
