Acts 4:13

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

I don't know about you, but when I read today's devotional verse, I pray that would be me too. I took this same verse and changed Peter and John's names to my name, but you can do the same where you change my name for your name.

Now when they saw the boldness of Steve, and perceived that he was uneducated and an untrained man, they marveled. And they realized that Steve had been with Jesus.

I mean, now come on, how cool would that be if our lives reflected that?

It's like when someone walks up to you at work or school or anywhere and asks you, "Are you a Christian?" and when you tell them that yes you are, they say, "I thought you were." Why?

Because you live your everyday life like you always do, and your life does not reflect the world, but Jesus. They can tell that it's not an act, or you putting on your Sunday best in church, because it's the real you and the real you spends a lot of time with Jesus. They realized that they had been with Jesus.

Another reason is in verse 20 of this same chapter, which Peter and John said:.

\$\displaysquare \text{Acts 4:20 For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.}

They saw Jesus, they walked with Jesus, they heard Jesus, how could they not tell of the wonderful things they experienced for three years with Jesus?

How long have you been walking with Jesus? Hasn't he done wonderful things in your life? For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.

What are you waiting for?
