Exodus 22:18 (KJV)

Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live.

Guess what we get to do today? That's right, according to the bible we are all going to go on a witch-hunt and find all the witches in our neighborhoods and get rid of them one by one. Ok, we re not going after actual witches, because that would be against the law. But look around and see what witches are you allowing in your home right now? What do I mean by that? Well, what movies are in your home that has a witch or witches in it? Does the name Harry Potter sound familiar?

Oh, you don't have any movies with witches in them? Well then, what about video games, even if they are not yours, do your kids have video games with witches in them that are in your home? Maybe you have an old witches costume that you wore years ago on Halloween, or even recently when you dressed up like a witch.

But thinking of these things, and now knowing that one of God's law is *Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live*. Ask yourself, are you allowing something in your house that God despised so much that He said to put it to death, but for you it's part of your entertainment?

Let's take this a little further, what about warlocks? No warlocks in your home, then what about vampires? There are movies and TV shows that make being vampires glamorous, and how many young or even older Christian girls and some guys flock to see these movies and even think that the young vampire guys are hot looking?

What about movies with demons and the walking dead in them? Are you as a Christian allowing the devil to entertain you with his demons, witches, zombies and vampires in movies and video games? And not only entertain you, but you also lust after some of these characters that the devil entices you with, thinking that if they were around you could see yourself being romantically involved with him or her.

I posted this once before and I think it applies here as well.

If you are going to heaven, then why are you living like you are going to hell?

Ask yourself, if you really think that Jesus or any of the disciples would consider these things as entertainment, like so many Christians do today.

Also check out your bible and see how Jesus dealt with such things in the bible? Did He allow them to be His entertainment? No, the bible says that when evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick. Matthew 8:16

Jesus got rid of that junk from people's lives, and if you asked any of those people who brought their demon possessed friends and family members to Jesus to be healed, what do you think that they would say to you right now if they saw some of the stuff that you have in your home?

Today, it may be time to check out what you are allowing into your home as part of you, and your families entertainment. Then ask yourself, "Am I allowing satan to entertain me with what God hates and what Jesus died for?"

- Deuteronomy 7:25-26 (MSG) Make sure you set fire to their carved gods. Don't get greedy for the veneer of silver and gold on them and take it for yourselves—you'll get trapped by it for sure. GOD hates it; it's an abomination to GOD, your God. And don't dare bring one of these abominations home or you'll end up just like it, burned up as a holy destruction. No: It is forbidden! Hate it. Abominate it. Destroy it and preserve GOD's holiness.
- Proverbs 6:16-19 (MSG) Here are six things GOD hates, and one more that he loathes with a passion:
 eyes that are arrogant,
 a tongue that lies,
 hands that murder the innocent,
 a heart that hatches evil plots,
 feet that race down a wicked track,
 a mouth that lies under oath,
 a troublemaker in the family.
