

Galatians 1:10 (NLT2)

Yet how often do Christians try to please others (the world), some with the way they dress, others with the music they listen to, some with the food they eat. † **2 Corinthians 6:17** *Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you."*

† **Matthew 16:26** *For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?*
