Gen 1:26-27

Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

No, no and no. If you read the story of creation in the book of Genesis, God never says Let Us make the sun, the water, the fish, the trees, the plants or anything else in Our image. No, not until He gets to the creation of man and woman. Then He says "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness" and after He does he says to "let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

So, go to the zoo or on a safari in Africa and enjoy the animals. Take a hike in the mountains and enjoy the trees and plants. Go to the Grand Canyon and enjoy the rock formations and cool colors in the earth and rocks. Gaze at the moon and stars at night and enjoy the romance of them. But never, EVER worship them or call them God or any part of God. They are just all of God's creation. But we on the other hand, are a part of God, because only in man did God breath life into, nothing else!
