

## Genesis 2:22

***Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man.***

I don't get this whole sexuality thing where people don't even know what sex they are, and that there are now multiple sexes that people can be. But the bible is clear that GOD create Man and Woman, Male and Female, period.

In yesterday's devotional, I used a car as an example, and I am going to again today, so I guess there is a car theme going on here this week. lol.

Would a car think, I was born as a car, but I think I'm an airplane, or I think I'm a bicycle, or I think I'm a boat. A car and an airplane both have doors and an engine, but that doesn't make them the same thing. Yes they are both a mode of transportation, but they are made different for people to get around in different ways. Just like a car and a boat are modes of transportation, but you can't drive a boat on the street, or sail a car in the water. Even a bicycle and a car are forms of transportation, but a bicycle doesn't have an engine, and it only has two wheels, as a car has four wheels.

Just like man and woman; yes, they are both human beings, but both are also made differently, just like a car and plane are different. Both a man and a woman are good for a lot of the same things. You can talk to both of them and they will talk back to you. Both of them can cook a meal, and walk somewhere to help you out. Both can watch your kids for you, both can teach you and help you out in various ways, both can drive a car and help you get somewhere. But even though man and woman are a lot alike, with two arms and two legs and two feet and two eyes, and two ears and one nose and have hair on their head and have finger and toe nails... need I go on?

But they are different, because a man can not have a baby. Sure they are a part of a baby being created, but to have a baby in a man's stomach, it just will never happen, just like a man can not breastfeed a baby, because God created man and woman the same, but also differently, and He did it for a purpose, and that was so that man and woman would populate the earth.

† ***Genesis 1:28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."***

You may wonder, why did God make woman to have a baby and not man? Honestly, it really doesn't matter, because God created man and woman how He wanted them to be created and for

the purpose that He created them to be different, and it wasn't so that a woman would ask, "*God, why didn't You make me like him, You did it wrong God, so I'll make myself like man.*" or the opposite is true for man, God didn't create him the way He did so that he could ask, "*Why didn't you make me like her, I want to be like her, so since You did it wrong God, I'll fix it myself and make myself to be like her.*"

Man created cars to drive on the road, and a car can't change itself by gluing wings on it's doors and think that it could fly, because it can't, because it wasn't created to. So no matter what you glue onto your body, or chop off (OUCH!!!) it won't change what God created you as, which is either a man or a woman.

If people would actually be more like King David when he wrote in one of the Psalms, saying that, "***I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well.***" **Psalm 139:14** They wouldn't worry or be disappointed with how God created them.

Think about that for a minute and just say, "***I am fearfully and wonderfully made*** by God", which means I am already wonderful and don't need to change a thing about how God created me. Not only that, when you look in the mirror all you would think is, "God, ***marvelous are Your works*** because You made me ***wonderfully***", which is not boasting on how great you are, but rather in how great God is for making you just exactly how He wanted you to be, and that is as a man or a woman. So don't try and make yourself something that you were never created to be, and don't mess with God's perfection, which is His creation of you, just the way you are!
