

**Heb 9:27**

*And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,*

Did you know that you have an appointment with God? That's how I read today's devotional verse.

How so? Because God know when you will die *and as it is appointed for men to die once* then when you do, you will face Him, *but after this the judgment.*

If you were scheduled to have a physical in about a month, how would you prepare for it? By eating junk food, staying up late every night and lying around doing nothing? No, you would eat right, get plenty of rest and exercise so when you see the doctor you will hopefully have a clean bill of health.

How are you preparing for your appointment with God?

I know lot of people feel like they do have an appointment with God every Sunday and their appointment last about an hour or so at church.

So how do they prepare for it? Sadly, most go out and party Friday and Saturday, and stagger into church on Sunday, half asleep, hung-over and even sleeping part of the time while they are in church.

Some even know we have an appointment with God, and will say, *"I have a few questions for God when I get to heaven."*

I don't know about you, but I know I will be speechless once I get to heaven, only able to say (as I do here on the earth) that "Jesus is Lord of lords and King of kings!"

Even scripture tells us that:
