"God my marriage is in a shambles, will you change my husband, or wife."

"God I want to serve you whole heartedly, but I need you to give me _____ first."

So did you catch it in each of these examples of how we ask God for help, and then tell God what we think He should do to help us?

Here in today's devotional verse, God was going to help Judah, yet not in the way that they thought He would. They may have expected for themselves to destroy their enemies with a great battle, yet God says: ***"Yet I will have mercy on the house of Judah, Will save them by the LORD their God, And will not save them by bow, Nor by sword or battle, By horses or horsemen."***

Meaning that it would not be by man's war or efforts that would save them, but rather by the Might Hand of God and how He chooses to do so. Because if you think about it, when it appears that we did it, then we boast in ourselves and not God. But when God does things that no man can do or take glory in, then God gets all the glory for it, not man

So just let God know what you need help with, then let Him take care of how He wants to. After all, He is God and we are not, therefore He knows better how to handle the situation then both you and I put together.
