## John 10:10

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

That's just what the thief is doing to our marriages, and we just sit back and let him do it. It's time to call the ultimate judge, Jesus to judge this thief and for us to clean up our homes from the mess this thief has done in it.

If your home were destroyed you wouldn't be happy in it, but when everything is in its place and in order then you enjoy your home.

So start putting things back in order in your marriage by first forgiving and loving one another.

If you have decided that you don't want to, then know that the devil is rejoicing and you will never have real joy in your marriage, or even in your relationship with Jesus.
