## So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God."

How many of you when you read today's devotional verse, thought or even said out loud "Amen"? Now how many of your non-Christian family members, friends or coworkers would ever think that you would agree with, or that you live out that statement of, "Have faith in God"?

If you were not a Christian, and you saw someone who claimed to be a Christian responding the way that you do when troubles arise, would you want their god (the world), or would you want their GOD (Creator of the world)?

- **Exodus 15:2** The LORD is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation; He is my God, and I will praise Him; My father's God, and I will exalt Him.
- Ruth 1:16 But Ruth said: "Entreat me not to leave you, or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God.
