

Matt 5:14-16

You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

There was a mass e-mail that went out last week asking people to go outside on Friday night at 7:00 PM and to light a candle. This was a nice gesture after all that happened last Tuesday, and please understand, I am not against this at all. But I think there is something that the USA, and even the world is missing here. You see, by 7:30 or 8:00 that same Friday night, most, if not all the candles were burned or blown out by those who had lit them.
