Romans 6:17-18 (NLT) Thank God! Once you were slaves of sin, but now you have obeyed with all your heart the new teaching God has given you. Now you are free from sin, your old master, and you have become slaves to your new master, righteousness.

If you are a believer, then know that according to God's word that you no longer have to be a slave to that sin.

If you are not a believer, know that according to God's word that you can be set free from that sin by turning your life over to Jesus Christ.

→ John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world.

He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

John 14:6ª Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life.
