

Proverbs 30:7-9

Two things I request of You (Deprive me not before I die): Remove falsehood and lies far from me; Give me neither poverty nor riches-- Feed me with the food allotted to me; Lest I be full and deny You, And say, "Who is the LORD?" Or lest I be poor and steal, And profane the name of my God.

This is one of my favorite Proverbs, because I feel like this so many times.

I have no desire to be rich, because if I was, I would fear that I would stop trusting in the Lord and trust in my riches instead. Therefore, I do not ask to be rich.

I also have a wife and children that I need to take care of, and I also support kids through Compassion. Therefore, I do not want to be poor, because I do not want them to go without and I end up doing something against the Lord to try to provide for them.

† *Or lest I be poor and steal, And profane the name of my God.*

† *Psalms 9:10 And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, LORD, have not forsaken those who seek You.*

† *Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the name of the LORD our God.*

† *Proverbs 22:19 I am teaching you today—yes, you— so you will trust in the LORD.*
