

Psalm 50:14-17

***“Offer to God thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High.
Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me.”***

But to the wicked God says:

***“What right have you to declare My statutes, Or take My covenant in your mouth,
Seeing you hate instruction And cast My words behind you?”***

I see posts everyday on Social Media with quotes of scripture. And 99% of the time the scriptures that are posted are scriptures of blessings from God. Now don't get me wrong, there is nothing wrong with that at all, and I would encourage everyone to post scripture to encourage others. The only thing is, when people do this, it's not giving the entirety of the gospel, and posting God's blessings are usually for believers, not non believers.

People are so quick to sugarcoat the gospel and not tell the whole truth, thinking they may offend someone, or they only want to tell people about the blessings of God, but never warn those that are not saved.

Looking at today's devotional verses, how many would post verses 14-15 on social media

† **Psalm 50:14-15** *Offer to God thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High. Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me.*

But not verses 16-17

† **Psalm 50:16-17** *But to the wicked God says: “What right have you to declare My statutes, Or take My covenant in your mouth, Seeing you hate instruction And cast My words behind you?”*

Didn't God say in His word:

† **Ezekiel 33:8-9** *When I say to the wicked, 'O wicked man, you shall surely die!' and you do not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand. Nevertheless if you warn the wicked to turn from his way, and he does not turn from his way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered your soul.*

If you think about it, we have a powerful ministry on Social Media. Think of all the non saved friends and family members that are there, and how many you can share the gospel with by posting Scriptures. But you know what, if all you post is God's blessings and not His warning to non believers, how many are not going to heaven, because you are afraid to post all that God says?

Today's devotional verses are one example. I actually did post all 4 verses on social media. Sure, I could have just posted the first two verses, but what good would that have been for a non-believer?

A study was done and it was found that 1 out of 1 persons will die, and over the last 6000 years, trillions of people have died no matter what people do or think, everyone one will die.

† **Hebrews 9:27** *And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment.*

Posting the blessings of God is great, but the lost do not benefit from those blessings, especially when it comes to eternity. How many reading this would never think to post Hebrews 9:27 (above) on social media. What? Are you afraid to offend your friends and family members, so you would rather them die in their sins, then offend them?

So go ahead and post those scriptures of blessings, but also post the gospel on your social media as well, because Jesus didn't say to go into the world and preach God's blessings to every creature, but rather, to "***preach the gospel to every creature.***"

† **Mark 16:15** *And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature."*

† **Acts 20:27** *For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God.*

† **1 Peter 1:25** *But the word of the LORD endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.*
