"Hello, can I call you back, I'm in church right now, or text me and I will text you back."

God wants to talk to you and listen to you while you praise Him. Don't give that time to anyone else, be it in church, or your One on one time with the Lord in your prayer closet, or while sitting in your devotional chair spending time with the Lord.
