

Titus 3:3-6 (NLT)

Once we, too, were foolish and disobedient. We were misled by others and became slaves to many wicked desires and evil pleasures. Our lives were full of evil and envy. We hated others, and they hated us.

But then God our Savior showed us his kindness and love. He saved us, not because of the good things we did, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins and gave us a new life through the Holy Spirit. He generously poured out the Spirit upon us because of what Jesus Christ our Savior did.

† **Gal 1:13 (NLT)** *You know what I was like when I followed the Jewish religion-how I violently persecuted the Christians. I did my best to get rid of them.*
